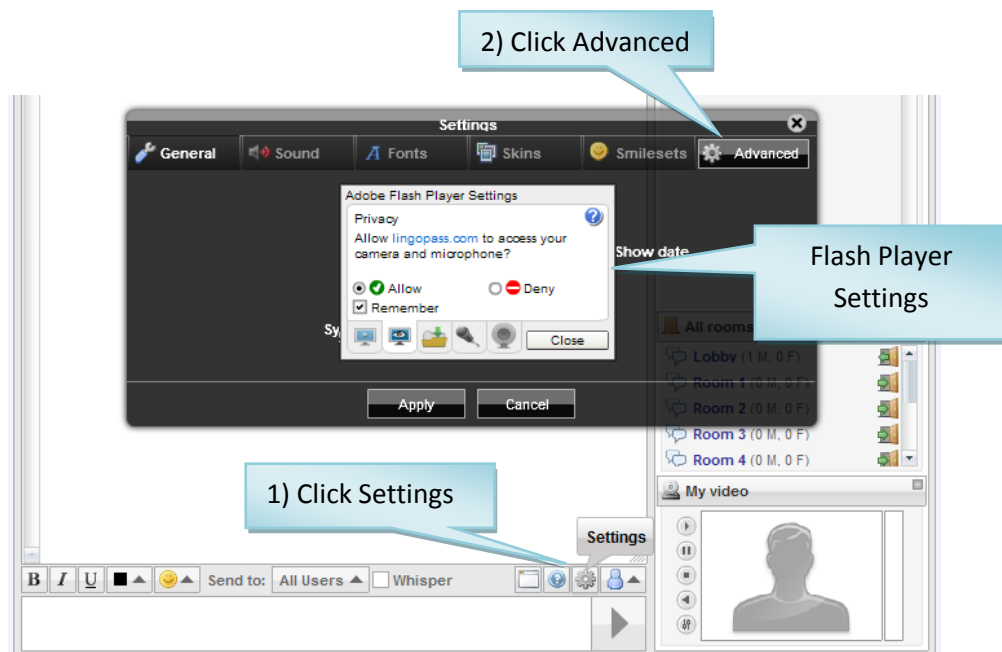
Setting Up Your Computer

Step 1 – Use Proper Equipment

Flash chat rooms work best with an **integrated headset** (headphones + microphone). External (or built-in) microphones + external speakers cause disturbing feedback to other users. You can solve this by listening through headphones (e.g. MP3 player)

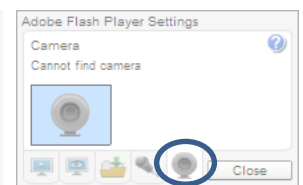
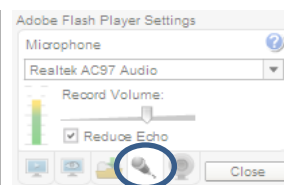
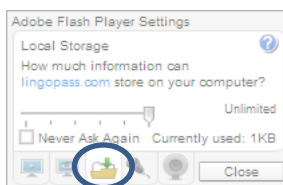
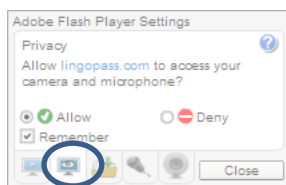
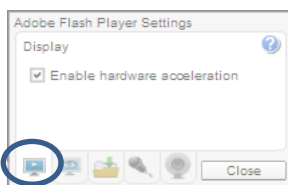


Step 2 – Open Your Flash Settings
